## **Description:**

Create a beautiful winter picture with a glowing sunset, colorful sky, and tall, snowy trees. Let your creativity make this winter scene come to life!

## Materials Needed:

- Acrylic paint in white, deep blue, black, red, orange, yellow
- Large and medium paint brushes
- Black felt pen
- Paper towel
- Water

### F-005 Winter Sun Art Project Instructions:

### 1. Prepare Your Art Sheet Paper

- a. Place your Art Cards by Kids Art Sheet upright on the table with the vertical arrows on the left side facing up.
- b. Gather your painting supplies

### 2. Write your name

a. At the top, write your name, teacher's name, age, and grade in big, bold letters using a marker or pen—no pencil!

### 3. Paint the Background

- a. Use your large paintbrush and deep blue paint.
- b. Paint the entire background blue and let it dry.

### 4. Paint the Sun's First Ring

- a. Take your large brush and yellow paint.
- b. Paint a big ring on the left side of the paper.

### 5. Blend the Second Ring

- a. While the yellow paint is still wet, use the same brush and orange paint.
- b. Paint a second ring inside the yellow one, lightly blending the two colors together.

#### 6. Fill in the Last Ring

- a. While the orange paint is still wet, use the same brush and red paint.
- b. Fill in the last part of the sun, blending the colors together gently.

#### 7. Paint the Trees

- a. Once the sun is dry, use your medium brush and black paint. Draw four vertical lines for trees that reach up three-quarters of the page.
- b. On each tree, paint three branches on both sides of the tree trunk.

### 8. Add Snow

- a. Use a sponge or medium paintbrush to blot white paint about 1 inch thick along the bottom for snow.
- b. Make sure to cover the bottoms of the trees. Let it dry.

## 9. Sign Your Name

a. Once everything is dry, use a black felt pen to sign your name above the snow.

# 10. Let It Dry Completely

a. Let the entire painting dry completely before handling or stacking it.
