Description:

Create a cute polar bear in a snowy winter scene, complete with falling snowflakes and a soft blue sky! This fun art project will bring your polar bear to life step by step.

Materials Needed:

- Watercolor paint in light blue, or blue and white mixed
- Large paint brush

- White crayon
- Paper towel
- Water

- Black permanent marker
- Pencil

F-007 Peekaboo Polar Bear Art Project Instructions:

1. Prepare Your Art Sheet Paper

- a. Place your Art Cards by Kids Art Sheet paper upright on the table with the vertical arrows on the left side facing up.
- b. Gather your painting supplies

2. Write Your Name

a. At the top, write your name, teacher's name, age, and grade in big, bold letters using a marker or pen—no pencil!

3. Draw Your Polar Bear

- a. Use a pencil to draw your bear. Start on the left and draw a big curve to the middle, then straight down.
- b. Add two small half-circles on top for the ears.

4. Make Snowflakes

a. Take your white crayon and draw snowflakes all over the background. Draw 4 lines like a star.

5. Paint the Sky

- a. Use light blue watercolour to paint the whole background. Be careful to not paint your bear.
- b. Your snowflakes will show up when you paint!

6. Outline the Polar Bear

- a. Once the paint is dry, use your black felt pen to trace your bear. Follow the pencil lines.
- b. Trace the ears as well.

7. Fill in the Ears

a. With your black felt pen, draw a small half-circle inside the ears and colour them in.

8. Draw the Face

- a. Use your black felt pen to draw two circles for the eyes.
- b. Draw a smaller circle below for the nose.
- c. From the nose, draw a line down, then two upside-down curves for the smile.

9. Sign Your Name

- a. Use your black felt pen to write your name at the bottom of your bear.
- b. Don't write too close to the black border, or it will get cut off!

10. Let it Dry

a. Let the entire painting dry completely before handling or stacking it.
