Description:

Learn to create an easy flower garden scene with cupcake wrappers! Just unfold a scalloped wrapper and watch the flowers appear!

Materials Needed:

- Two deeply scalloped cupcake wrappers in patterns and colors of your choice (🧁)
- Acrylic paint in blue, white, green, yellow
- Large paint brush
- Paint palette with water
- Glue stick
- Black permanent marker
- Paper towel

S-108 Easy Cupcake Flowers Art Project Instructions:

1. Prepare Your Art Sheet Paper

- a. Place your Art Cards by Kids Art Sheet on the table vertically. Make sure the vertical arrows on the left side are pointing upwards.

2. Write your name

- a. At the top, write your name, teacher's name, age, and grade in big, bold letters using a marker or pen—no pencil!

3. Paint your Background

- a. Mix blue and white paint in your palette to make a light sky blue.
- b. With your paint brush, paint the entire background in broad strokes.
- c. Allow the paint to dry fully before moving to the next step.

4. Flatten your Cupcake Wrappers

- a. Flatten your cupcake wrappers by carefully spreading them out on a flat surface.
- b. Place them on the page to determine where you would like them to be glued down, but don't glue yet. Place them high enough to allow room for stems and grass below.
- c. Set aside wrappers for now.

5. Paint Stems, Leaves, and Grass

- a. With your green paint and paint brush, paint two stems leading to where the wrappers will be placed coming up from the bottom of the Art Sheet.
- b. Paint two leaves coming out of both sides of two stems.
- c. Paint grass coming up from the bottom of the page, making sure the entire bottom of the Art Sheet is painted in a layer of grass.
- d. Add an extra layer of paint once it is dry for a brighter color if needed.

6. Glue Down the Wrappers

- a. With your glue stick, apply a generous layer of glue on the back of one cupcake wrapper and place down onto the page while pressing firmly, at the end of one of the stems.
- b. Repeat for the second wrapper.
- c. Lift up the edges and add extra glue if needed.

7. Paint the Center of the Wrapper

- a. With your white paint and brush, paint circles in the center of each wrapper as a base layer. This will make the center color of the flower pop in the next step.
- b. Allow the paint to fully dry before moving onto the next step.

8. Paint Color in the Center

- a. With your yellow paint and brush, paint a bright layer directly overtop of the white paint.

9. Sign Your Name

- a. Use your permanent marker to sign your name below one of the leaves, at least 1 finger width away from the black border of your Art Sheet.

10. Let It Dry

- a. Let the entire painting dry completely before handling or stacking.
