Description:

Learn how to draw a festive snowman step by step! Follow along to sketch your own snowman with a cozy scarf, a carrot nose, and a tall top hat decorated with holly. Add playful wind swirls, then bring it to life with bright colours and bold outlines.

Materials Needed:

- Felt-tip markers in red, orange, yellow, green, and black
- Pencil with eraser
- Optional: black permanent marker

Difficulty Level: Grade 1-2

F-064 Snowman on a Blustery Day Art Project Instructions:

1. Prepare Your Art Sheet Paper

- a. Place your Art Cards by Kids Art Sheet on the table vertically. Make sure the vertical arrows on the left side are pointing upwards.
- b. Gather the necessary supplies for your artwork.

2. Write your name

a. At the top, write your name, teacher's name, age, and grade in big, bold letters using a marker or pen—no pencil!

3. Outline the Snowman

- a. With the pencil, draw the snowman outline on the left side of the page.
- b. Follow the snowman outline example in the corresponding video.
- c. Draw four wind swirls on the right-hand side of the page, blowing to the right.

4. Colour the Nose

a. With the orange marker, colour in the carrot nose.

5. Colour Red Details

- a. With the red felt-tip marker, colour in various sections of the scarf.
- b. Fill in the berries with colour.

6. Colour Yellow Details

- a. With the yellow felt-tip marker, colour in various sections of the scarf.
- b. Fill in the band that goes across the center of the top hat with colour.

7. Colour Green Details

- a. With the green felt-tip marker, colour in various sections of the scarf.
- b. Fill in the holly leaves with colour.

8. Colour Black Details

- a. With the black felt-tip marker, colour in the circles for the eyes and the mouth.
- b. Colour in the entire top hat, carefully going around the berries, leaves, and band.

9. Outline the Drawing

- a. With the black felt-tip marker or permanent black marker, outline the entire snowman, tracing over all the pencil lines.
- b. Add detail lines to the nose and leaves.

10. Erase Pencil Marks

a. With your eraser, make sure to erase all of the visible pencil lines left after outlining.

11. Sign Your Name

- a. On the snowman's body under the scarf, sign your name in black permanent marker.
- b. Don't sign your name too close to the black border or it will get cut off!
