Description:

Learn how to draw a beautiful monarch butterfly that lands on a vibrant purple flower for snack. This art piece is suitable for all ages and can be modified and adapted to any creative ideas!

Materials Needed:

- Watercolour paint in light blue
- Pencil and eraser
- Felt tip markers in orange, black, green, and purple
- Black permanent marker
- White acrylic paint
- Large round brush and small liner brush
- Paper towel
- Water

S-029 Sweet Nectar Art Project Instructions:

1. Prepare Your Art Sheet Paper

- a. Place your Art Cards by Kids Art Sheet on the table vertically. Make sure the vertical arrows on the left side are pointing upwards.

2. Write your name

- a. At the top, write your name, teacher's name, age, and grade in big, bold letters using a marker or pen—no pencil!

3. Outline the Butterfly

- a. With the pencil, outline the wings, wing design, head, eyes, body, and antennae of the butterfly.
- b. Please see the corresponding video for visual instructions.

4. Outline the Flower

- a. With the pencil, outline the flower petals, sepals, stem, and the legs of the butterfly.
- b. Please see the corresponding video for visual instructions.

5. Paint the Background

- a. With the light blue watercolour paint and large brush, paint the entire background, leaving the butterfly and flower white. Mix the paint and water thoroughly for a vibrant colour.
- b. Allow to dry before moving on to the next step.

6. Colour in the Wing Details

- a. With the orange felt tip marker, colour in all of the outlined tear-drop shapes on the wings.

7. Colour in the Flower

- a. With the purple felt tip marker, colour in the outlined flower petals.

8. Colour in the Stem and Sepals

- a. With the green felt tip marker, colour in the outlined sepals and stem.

9. Colour in the Wings

- a. With the black felt tip marker, colour in the remaining white areas of the wings, carefully going around the orange areas.

10. Colour in the Body

- a. With the black felt tip marker, colour in the butterfly's head. Trace around the eyes and add semi-circles into the white of the eyes as pupils.
- b. Colour in the entire body of the butterfly.

11. Outline Everything

- a. With the black permanent marker, outline all of the original pencil lines including the antennae, legs, body, head, wings, wing details, flower petals, sepals, and stem.

12. Add White Markings

- a. With the white paint and liner brush, add small dots from the mid-section up to the tops of the forewings and the hindwings.
- b. Add a second layer of paint if necessary for a brighter white.
- c. Allow to dry.

13. Sign Your Name

- a. With the black permanent marker, sign your name under the flower.
- b. Don't sign your name too close to the border or it will get cut off!
